Setup Guide for Assembling a Square Shower Frame and Base


Step 1:


Step 2:






Step 6:

Installing the Door Rails Place two door rails at the front of the shower tray, following the image provided for reference.




Step 7:

Connecting the Door Rail Connector Blocks Attach the door rail connector blocks at the midpoint where the door rails meet. This applies to both the top and bottom door rails.




Step 10:

Door Adjustment The top wheels serve the purpose of adjusting the door's level. Attach the magnetic door strips and trim them to the appropriate length. Also, attach the door handle for added convenience. The bottom wheels come with a push-button for a quick-release mechanism.



Step 12:

Wheel Installation

Hang the top wheels onto the top curved rail.


Insert the bottom wheels into the bottom curved rail using the provided buttons.

If the bottom wheels fail to spring back up into the curved rail or if the door is not level, adjust the top wheel using the screw located below it.

Splash Strips Finally, attach water splash strips to both the front fixed glass and the inner section of the door. Trim any excess splash strip material for a neat and tidy appearance.
